York & North Yorkshire

Artificial Intelligence

The Chamber hosted an event about the First Steps in AI for businesses who were interested in hearing more about AI and machine learning. Charlie was one of the two hosts of the event, where speakers from North Yorkshire told businesses about the ways that they had applied AI to their business.

Devolution

Charlie, James and Sarah met with Felicity Cunliffe-Lister, the Liberal Democrat candidate for mayor, as part of wider talks with the mayoral candidates. The Devolution Alliance interviews are almost completed, and the paper is set to be published in April.

Hospitality
